- The Seekers: *Do I Stay Christian* by Brian McLaren (Book Study)
Do I Stay Christian? addresses in public the powerful question that surprising numbers of people—including pastors, priests, and other religious leaders—are asking in private. Picking up where Faith After Doubt leaves off, *Do I Stay Christian?* is not McLaren's attempt to persuade Christians to dig in their heels or run for the exit. Instead, he combines his own experience with that of thousands of people who have confided in him over the years to help listeners make a responsible, honest, ethical decision about their religious identity. - *Hate Mail: Paul's fiery letter to the Galatians* Led by Mike Lockaby, Room 101
Paul's letter to the Galatians is short -- only 149 verses -- but Paul packs in a lot of thinking and not a little vitriol. As one of his first two letters (scholars argue whether it is first or second), Paul writes a letter to the Galatians, clearly still hot under the collar from an explosive encounter with Cephas, the Apostle Peter. Who do you think won when they faced each other? Who won the argument from our vantage point 2,000 years later? Who do you think should have won? As we pass through the Season of Easter, the time of celebration of the Good News, what is Paul's vision of it? Led by Mike Lockaby, Room 101

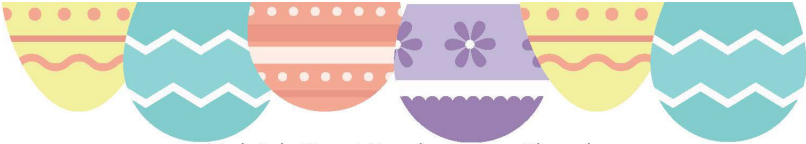

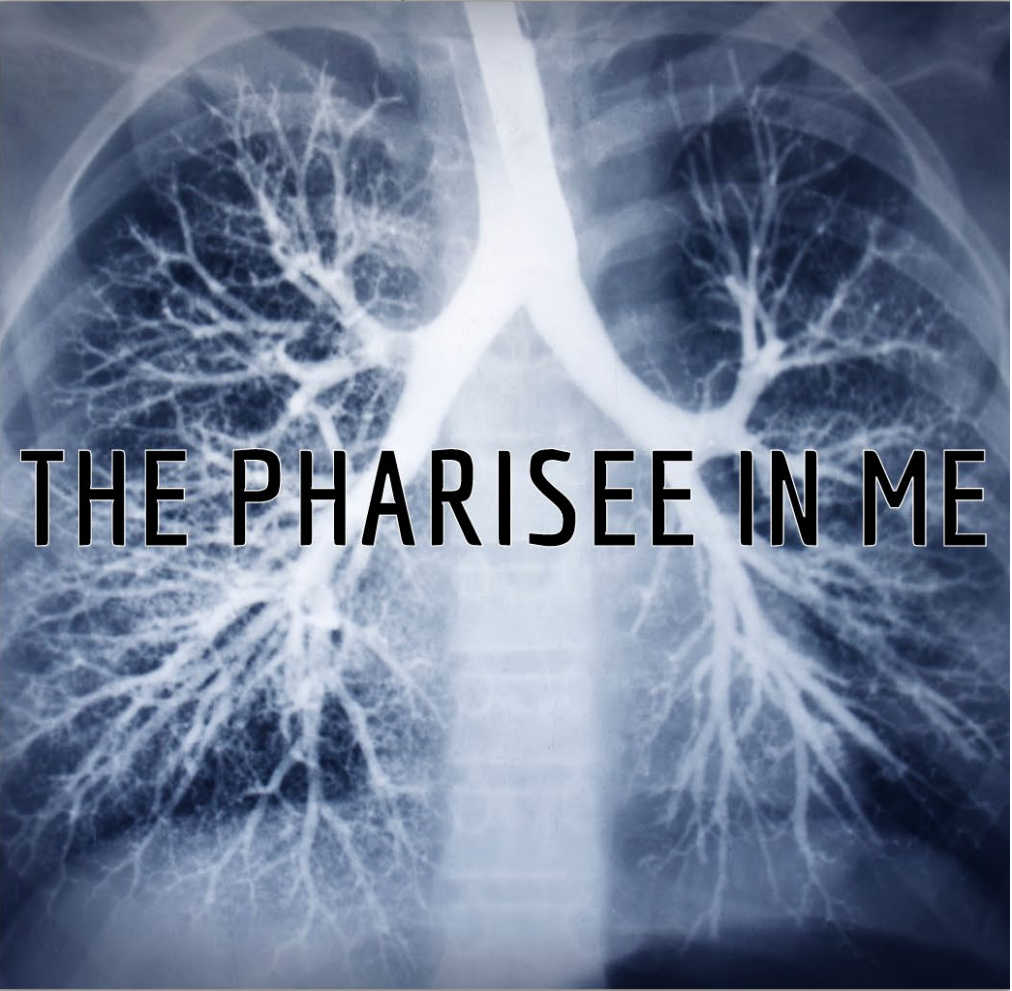
